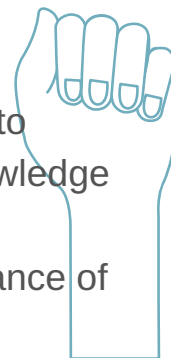


# As a PRINCIPLED PROVIDER

I believe in...

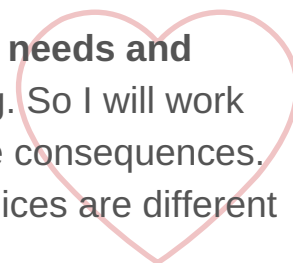
## PATIENT AUTONOMY

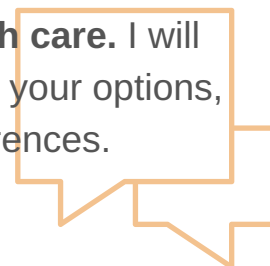
## HARM REDUCTION

## SHARED DECISION-MAKING

If I am required by law to share the results of drug screenings, I will advise you of that and we will work together to make a plan to help reduce the potential harm of that report.
